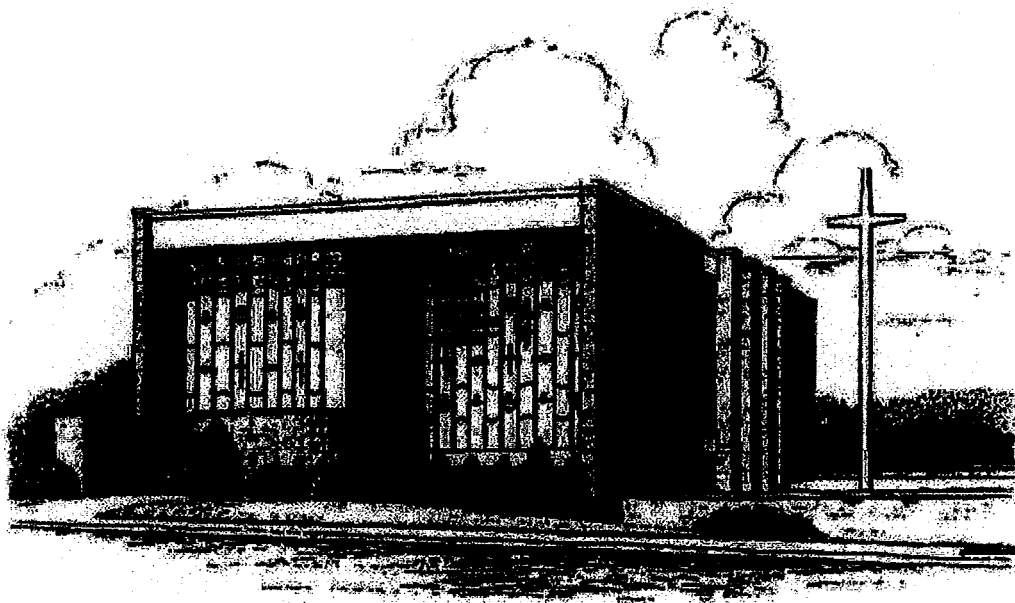

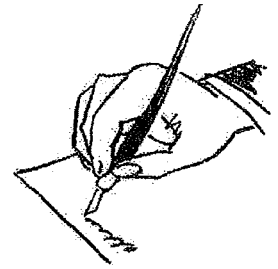

THE PASTOR'S PEN



Well, the start of our New Year has certainly been interesting! With the loss of our heating system we have had to learn the value of adaptation and adjustment.

Thank God and Praise the Lord for this congregation of God. So understanding, patient, and adaptable, thank you for adjusting to our need to worship in the Social Room while we await repairs. Thank you too, for discovering joy in the process. Many have commented on how pleasant it is to worship in the relaxed setting of the Social Room, how much more conversation takes place, and how refreshing it is. We had to change, but the heart of who we are remains the same. The setting and presentation is a little different, but the rhythm and pattern is familiar as always. Could there be a spiritual lesson here?

This month we begin the season of Lent; six weeks during which disciples consider their living and adjust their practices to deepen and strengthen their relationship with God and one another. We do this in preparation for celebrating the glory of Christ's resurrection at Easter. Perhaps the adjustments we have had to make temporarily in worship are an example to us of some adaptations we need to make in ministry as a church.

So many in society seem to have lost values and quality of life. Many seem to have lost hope and vitality. Some suffer brokenness, lack of meaning, and purpose. So many have turned to the wrong things, searching for that which we value so much. Some may not realize how empty their lives may be.

Could it be, if we adapt and adjust to meet their needs we may fulfill God's purpose for us, representing Christ, and help them to better lives, through discovering the peace, love, and joy of Jesus.

Let us show our devotion to God by helping people to find faith. Let's invite folks to our fellowship. Let us share fellowship and worship. Let's pray for the people around us, for their families, situations, and our relationships. Let us ask God to show us the way to reach them. Doing so will surely bless them, us, church, and our celebration of Easter this year in many wonderful ways.

Worship Schedule (Lent)

We are about to enter the church season called "Lent". Traditionally this is the period of 40 days (not counting Sundays) prior to Easter. (Sundays are not counted because every Sunday, throughout the year, is a celebration of the meaning and glory of Easter). The period of forty days was chosen in order to remind the faithful of the time Jesus spent in the wilderness before beginning his ministry. We use these forty days to recognize, reflect, repent, and prepare for Easter and our ministry beyond. Here is the schedule of Worship for this year's observance of Lent and Easter.

Wednesday, February 14 Ash Wednesday Worship at Noon and 7:00 PM

Lent begins with burning the palms we used to proclaim Jesus as our King on Palm Sunday, and marking ourselves with the ashes as a sign of repentance for how we have sinned and fallen short as followers of Christ our Lord.

This year we are offering two services to observe this holy day and season.

12:00 Noon: A short, quiet service of prayer, reflection and repentance, held in the sanctuary.

7:00 PM: Readings, Prayers, with a focus on gratitude for our salvation and devoting ourselves to growing faith and witness through this holy season.

Sunday, March 25 Palm Sunday Worship at 9:00 and 11:00 AM

This is the day we recall Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem as the beginning of Holy Week. We will give palm crosses to all worshippers as a token of our devotion and love for Christ.

Thursday, March 29 Maundy Thursday Dinner and Worship at 6:00 PM

This Holy night is the commemoration of the last night Jesus shared with his Disciples before being betrayed and crucified. They celebrated the Passover and He instituted Holy Communion. Like them, we will gather for a fellowship meal in the social room, highlighted by our remembrance and participation in Holy Communion as today's disciples with Christ.

Friday, March 30 Good Friday Community Worship Noon – 3:00 PM

Annual Community Worship Service commemorating the suffering and death of Jesus Christ upon the cross, paying the price for our sins, that we might be saved. Divided into seven 25-minute segments. The public is invited to part or all of this service. Seven pastors preach on the last words of Christ, and there are seven special music offerings on this holiest of days.

6:30 AM Sunrise Service (outdoors) at Mt. Prospect Cemetery

9:00 AM Traditional Easter Worship Service

11:00 AM Contemporary Easter Celebration

The Worship Committee will be decorating the altar for Easter Sunday with lilies. You may order a lily in honor or memory of a loved one.

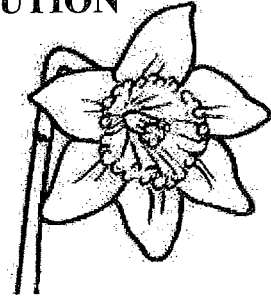

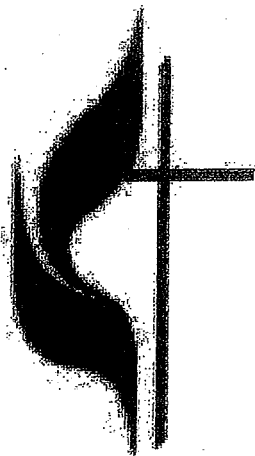
