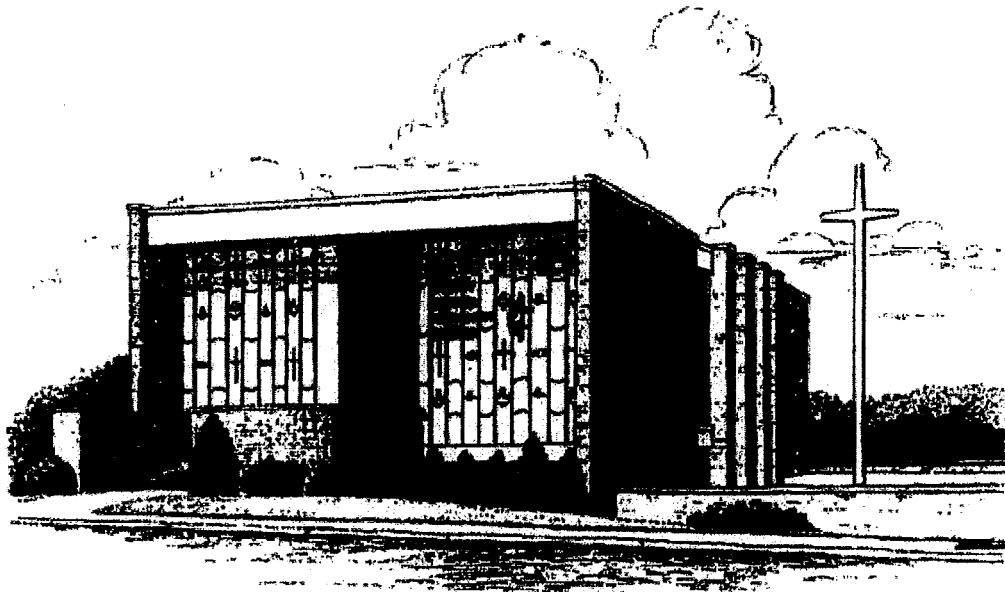

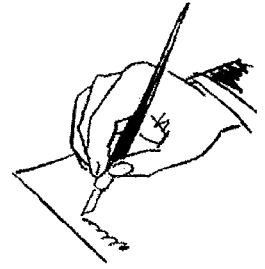

# THE PASTOR'S PEN



## *Time of Harvest*

*Have you seen how crowded the Ambrose Market has been the last few weeks? Everyday folks are trying to get a few more ears of corn, tomatoes, and other produce that make summer such a joy. But they are also buying apples and squash, and pumpkins. Promotions for “Pumpkin Spice” are popping up everywhere. It’s harvest time!*

*Jesus said: “My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to complete his work. Do you not say, ‘Four months more, then comes the harvest’? But I tell you, look around you, and see how the fields are ripe for harvesting.” (John 4:34-35)*

*Let us look around and see, as Jesus saw, as the disciples came to see, that yes, indeed the fields are ripe for harvest. What is the produce we should be gathering in? We are excited to have a new Missions project this year at Trinity for Make a Difference Day. We will be collecting items for inmates at the Allegheny County Jail. When we contacted the clergy's office at the county jail and asked what we could do to make a difference, we were told that they were looking for people to donate some items that would truly be a blessing for some less unfortunate people. She went on to say that inmates sometimes are incarcerated in the summer in shorts and tank tops then are released in the winter, so they would need donations of warm clothing. There are inmates that have no family to put money on their books and no way of even getting basic essentials that they need.

Everything goes through the clergy's office, so donations will go to those in truly the greatest need. How sad it is that some inmates don't have anyone who cares enough to be there to pick them up when they are released. We truly can make a difference in their lives.

Collection boxes will be placed in the Narthex and across from the office for you to donate these items. Collection will be from September 10th to October 22nd.

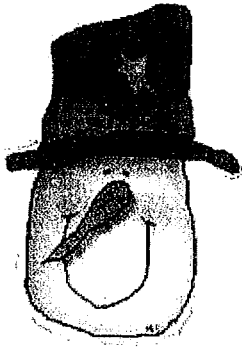

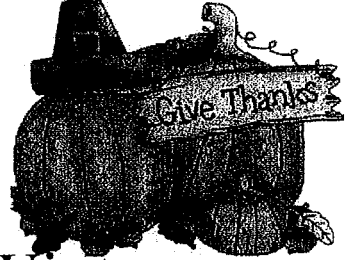

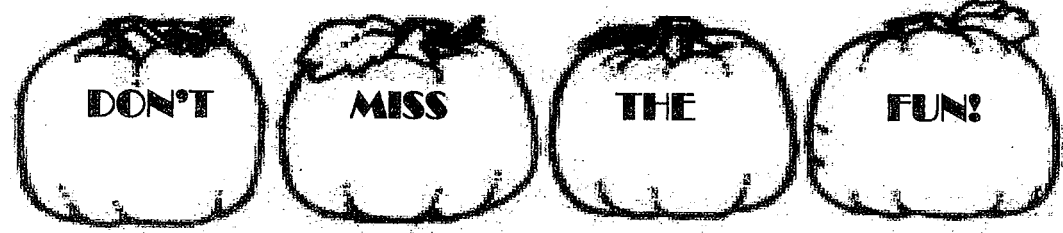

Let us pray for these students and leaders as they grow together, and help all of us to do the same through their fellowship and study.

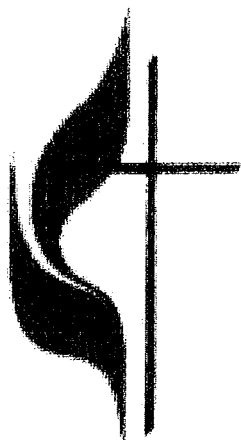
### **Annual Charge Conference**
